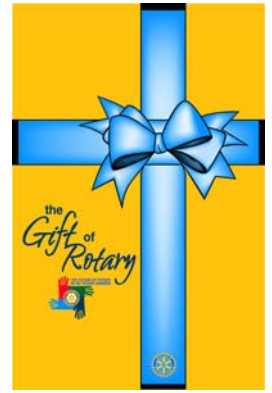

## Requirements for participation

### **Table for every club (maximum of 2 tables per club); they are FREE!**

- # All tables must remain in the quad area as set up
- # May hand out any information regarding club fundraisers, club projects and may sell any items that the club sells to raise money, i.e., tickets, goods, etc.
- # May request donations to their projects and collect money on the spot
- # Must have a minimum of two members manning the table at all times, however may have as many of their club members behind their tables as they want without imposing on another clubs tables
- # Must remain behind their tables. Cannot block access to any other clubs table with signs, etc.
- # May have posters and/or club banners behind their tables and must provide their own means of hanging posters or banners, no hangers will be provided for them
- # May decorate their tables as they see fit
- # Must be set up by 7:15 a.m. and must be dismantled after lunch
- # Must dispose of all trash and leave site as if never used
- # **Everyone manning the tables must be registered for Assembly and attend the sessions following the close of the Fair at 8:50 a.m.**
- # Those clubs who wish to continue selling or passing out their information fliers can do so outside the cafeteria in a manner not imposing upon the diners. Locations near the stair wells can be utilized for this purpose
- # You may hand out fliers, brochures, club information, fundraising materials, and club business cards
- # You may display lists of your Paul Harris Fellows, members, officers, etc.
- # You may display containers for contributions to your fundraising projects
- # You may sell any items that you are normally selling to raise funds for your club or Rotary International Foundation
- # Everything on your table must be related to your Rotary Club and its programs, members and events
- # The tables will be 'guarded' while you are in the sessions by volunteer Interact Students so no need to break down early so you can get to the opening session. Please don't leave valuables on the tables when you go to the Assembly. Removal of all items from tables must be done before you go to lunch.
